PLANNING APPLICATIONS - (the full list can be seen on the Notice Board).

Knotty Cross, Halewood Road - to erect 1 3-bedroom house in garden.

We have written to the C.P.O. saying we feel this development to be too large for the site and asking about access.

Bear & Staff, Gateacre Brow - Illuminated post sign.

We think this sign would be overbearing and out of character in the Conservation Area. We have suggested a return to the original Bear and Ragged Staff hanging sign, there c.1800.

7 Halewood Road - to retain U.P.V.C. windows.

Once again we have the problem of these plastic windows in the Conservation Area, this time on a listed building. How do we make residents aware that new or replacement windows require planning consent before they are installed?

La Girelle, Oakfield Avenue - the application to demolish this house, built in 1953, architect Walter Lewis, F.I.A.S., L.R.I.B.A and to erect 3 houses on the site was granted on the 3rd July.

M57 - A562 LINK ROAD - we were asked for our comments on two different routes by Transportation Planning Associates. Our reply was that we would welcome any scheme leading to less traffic through the village.

ELM HOUSE, CHILDWALL - The new Childwall amenity society has been formed just in time. There is an application for a huge extension to this listed house, next to the Church, now a Nursing Home. We are supporting the Childwall Society in their objections and hope that this application will be refused.
